2022-2023 Tennessee Missions Emphasis



Approximately 80% of the population of most counties will not worship in any church this Sunday. That's 1,000 unchurched people for every SBC church in TN.

More than 1 million people of immigrant or refugee backgrounds live in Tennessee.

25.3% of every 1,000 births were to women ages 15-19.
10,880 abortions reported in Tennessee by CDC.

65% of 4th grade students are NOT performing at or above a proficient level in reading.

58,000 people from Tennessee are behind bars. About half of the state's prisoners released each year return to prison within three years.

TN is one of the hungriest states in the country. 1 in 8 people in TN face hunger & 15.6% of households face food insecurity.

TN is in the top 15 states in drug overdose deaths. Each year, more opioid prescriptions are written than the number of people living in TN.

TBI reports human trafficking is the second-highest rising crime in the state. Every county in TN has reported cases of human trafficking.

There are over 4 million unchurched or spiritually lost people in the state of Tennessee with currently 6.94 million people living in Tennessee.

An average of 15-25 TBC churches close each year.

Kentucky Flooding Response

1. Two large generators to get power back on to some key locations were sent to KY immediately following the flood. Both units ran for days until local power was restored. Both units have now been returned and are being serviced for the next disaster.
2. TN Baptist Disaster Relief Incident Command team set up operations in Carrie, KY at Montgomery Baptist Church opening the door for Assessment Teams to go and begin assessing the damage. Following their assessments Flood Recovery Teams were dispatched and have made remarkable strides in preparing the homes for the rebuild process to begin.
3. God's Warehouse volunteers have received, sorted, and packed at least 22 truckloads of much needed supplies (including food, water, cleaning supplies as well as some furniture and building supplies) that have already been shipped to KY. This work continues daily as the needs are great in many areas of Kentucky.

According to Don Owen and other DR leaders, it will be a long-term effort to assist many of the people who have lost so much during this flood. God's Warehouse is open 9—3 Monday through Friday to receive donations. Please call 423-312-6883 to be sure volunteers are available before making a delivery to the warehouse.
