



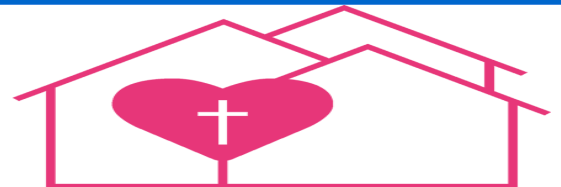

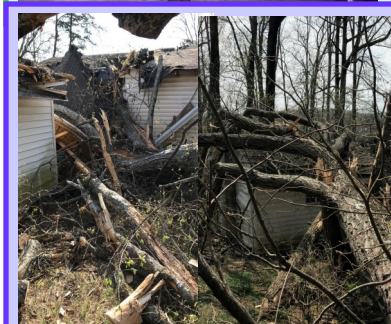
## Disaster Relief & God's Warehouse
