

Recently God's Warehouse received a call from World Emergency Relief, a great partner in California, who asked if a 38,000 pound load of frozen chicken, turkey, ham and beef could be used. The cost would be to pay for half of the \$2,600 freight bill from Texas. Because of the wonderful support of the Association's churches and many generous donors to God's Warehouse, the funds were available.

The meats have first been distributed throughout the Appalachian region of northeast Tennessee and Kentucky to families with school age children.
