Ukraine Containers #12 & #13

The photos below are from the distribution of the last two containers (12 and 13) that were shipped in April and May. There are about 9 hospitals that have already received various medical supplies for people in dire need due to the war in Ukraine. You will also find a group of six pastors. They expressed so much gratitude for the help their churches and the people around their churches received from these containers. This is a HUGE help and a blessing that is needed more than ever.









The **Critical Medical Team** at God's Warehouse has been busy sorting, inspecting and packing supplies for Israel. Containers #117 and #118 shipped on August 6th and 7th. Combined they contained over \$10 million

in donated medical supplies from Kingsway Pharmacy. Two more containers for Israel were scheduled to ship on August 9th.



The **Swift Water Team** was deployed to North Carolina on August 6th to assist with flooding. Debby made landfall in Florida as a hurricane and downgraded to a tropical storm as she moved into the Carolinas.
