During this year's SBC annual meeting, IMB President Paul Chitwood emphasized the importance of working together. "Your IMB missionaries are addressing **the world's greatest problem with the only solution, God's solution — the gospel.** But they need your prayers, your support, your continued generosity and more workers in the harvest," he said.

Because of their steadfast presence among the nations, 3,521 missionaries and 95 Global Missionary Partners were able to engage 67 new people groups and places and see 178,177 people come to Christ last year.

"This can only happen if we work together to raise up more missionaries and champion the Lottie Moon offering and the Cooperative Program," Chitwood continued.

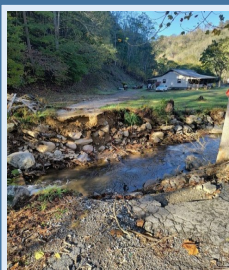

The top pictured shows a home completely underwater. The second picture is the same home after the water has receded. Demo and rebuild has begun.

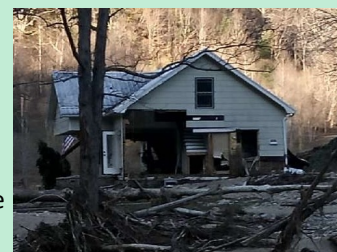

Below is a list of a few of the "Blessings" completed....

- Shipped 11 Tractor Trailer Loads of supplies to Florida (2 hurricanes)
- Received & Delivered 6 RV's (campers) to families in Upper East Tennessee
- Received & Delivered 4 automobiles to families in Upper East Tennessee
- Delivered more than 280 Generators complete with gas cans and extension cords
- Received and distributed hundreds of tents, sleeping bags and camping supplies
- Delivered over 1,160 loads of supplies to distribution points in TN & NC
- Fed up to 105 volunteers on a daily basis
- Provided commercial freezers & refrigerators to partnering agencies
- Provided teams to rebuild bridges across streams washed out by the storm
- Supported teams to clear streams and property of debris, sand and rock
- Delivered rock to rebuild roadways and driveways
- Provided teams to mud out homes and begin rebuilding them
- Started construction on one home from the ground up
- Opened 3 additional warehouse locations to store and distribute furniture and building supplies
- Provided Search & Rescue teams
- Partnered with TBMB in the Rise & Rebuild project
