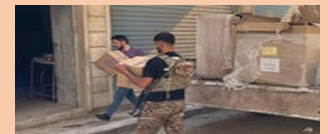
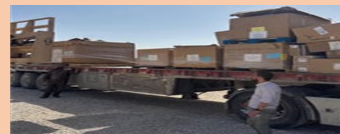
EF4 Tornado
