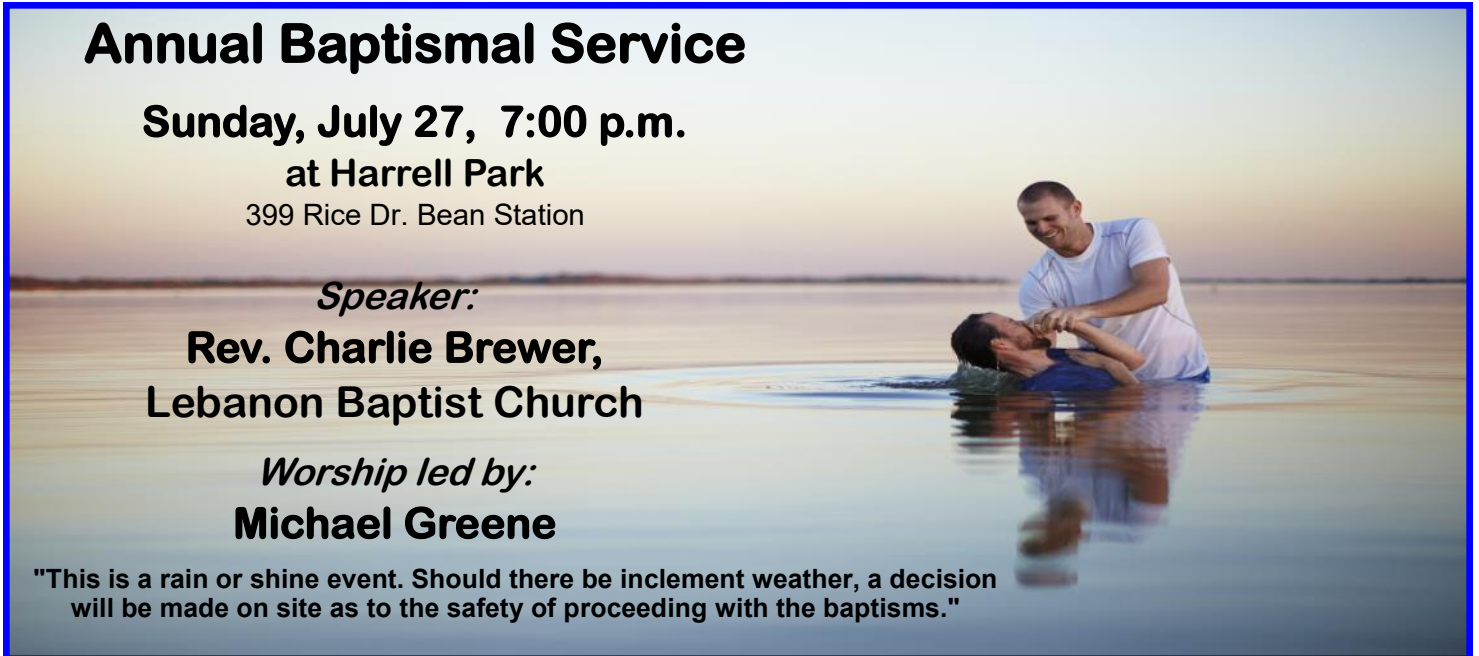

Blue Oval City Vision Tour

Anyone interested in going on a Vision Trip to Blue Oval City in West Tennessee? Blue Oval City is the site of the largest automotive manufacturing plant in North America. The Tennessee Baptist Mission Board wants to saturate this entire community with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. This work will mean helping existing churches in equipping, resourcing and training. On top of that, a goal has been set to plant 40 churches in the next 10 years!

On **August 18-20**, anyone from Harvest Field 6 who would like to see what God is doing in Blue Oval City and get more information about how they can partner with this effort are strongly encouraged to travel over to West Tennessee. The plan is to leave Monday, August 18, meet with Danny Sinquefield and a couple of church planters on Monday evening. Then, all day Tuesday we will tour the region, visit existing churches as well as new church plants already at work. We will return home on Wednesday. Lodging will probably be a hotel in Jackson.
