12 Things a Church Can Do To Protect Minors

Since Bible School is upon us, here are a few tips for keeping kids, volunteers, and staff safe.

1. Institute the Two-Adult Rule
2. Institute the Six-Month Rule
3. Carefully select all volunteers and staff who work with minors
4. Provide training to volunteers & staff who work with minors
5. Provide supervision of volunteers and staff
6. Institute communication policy
7. Develop a comprehensive security plan for church
8. Engage Parents as Partners in Ministry
9. Put windows in all classroom doors
10. Avoid transportation in private vehicles
11. Communicate policies to church
12. Prepare an allegation response plan

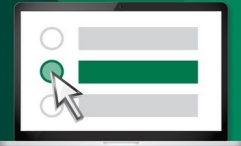

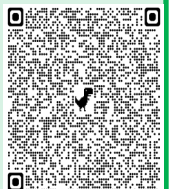


